Need a Letter of Recommendation?

Many college applications, as well as scholarship applications require a Letter of Recommendation. Here are some tips:

1. Ask an adult (non-relative) who knows you best
2. Give plenty of time. Ask for the letter 2-3 weeks before it is due
3. Provide background information. Give your recommend-er a resume, or fill out a [Personal Profile](#) so they can include more about you.

Check Your Name Spelling for Graduation

Remember to check your name and spelling on the counseling center window. The name that will be used is your full given name. This will be available starting January 24.
