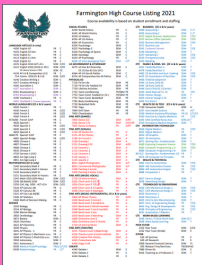
JUNIOR UPDATES

Juniors will take the State ACT March 7. Pre-administration for the test will happen February 21 in MAPS classes.

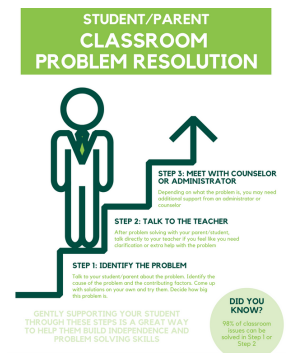
Scholarship Presentations
