
- 1. There are two ways to apply to Westminster College:



2. If completing the application on Westminster's website, students will create an account and fill out the application.



3. When reaching the end of the application, students are asked to "Submit Application".

There is **NO APPLICATION FEE** when applying as an undergraduate student to Westminster College.






4. Once an application is submitted, you will want to click on the tab along the top left corner of the screen that reads: "My Account"




- 5. In order to see what supplemental items need to be sent to the Office of Admission to finish your application, you will need to view your account and scroll to the bottom of the page to the box that shows the status of your application.

Create a New Application

- i. Personal statement or graded paper
 - 1. This can be uploaded directly onto your application by clicking on "Submit Supplemental Items".



- ii. High School Transcript
- iii. ACT or SAT scores
 - 1. We will accept unofficial test scores if they are included on your High School Transcript.

Deferral Process: Once Admitted, students can apply online to defer their admission and merit scholarship for up to two years. Please contact the office of Admissions with any questions.
