# Need a Letter of Recommendation?

Many college applications, as well as scholarship applications require a Letter of Recommendation. Here are some tips:

- 1.Ask an adult (non-relative) who knows you best
- 2. Give plenty of time. Ask for the letter 2–3 weeks before it is due
- 3. Provide background information. Give your recommend-er a resume, or fill out a *Personal Profile* so they can include more about you.

# Check Your Name Spelling for Graduation
