## Agenda Items

- 1. Activity Bus: The district has not determined who will shoulder the cost of the bus which runs \$3,000-5,000 per term. There will be a bus but it may only run certain days during certain seasons based on funding.
- 2. Cleanliness of the School: Discussion of natural consequences. Suggestion to run a Nix News segment and possible a PLT lesson.
- 3. Athletic/Activity Eligibility: % in summit can be deceiving. After 2 weeks any "I" given will roll to a F grade. WE have been flexible this year but will need to have a solid policy for next year on when and if those grades can be changed.
- 4. Learning First Day/Budget: Reminder that 29<sup>th</sup> March will be the Learning first day with the district to approve SIP plan and budget for 2019-2020.

## Other items discussed

- 1. Farmington will be adding 10 teachers for sure and possible 2-3 more. Our official numbers for next year sit at 1998
- 2. Questions was asked about the retention ponds: The retention pond areas were hydroseeded previously. Hogan construction estimates that it will take up to 3 years for the grass to grow in. District personnel who have been working on the project do not necessarily want to wait that long. They are currently looking into pricing for placing sod in both pond areas.
- 3. Question was asked about private tutoring: Justin contacted Scott Zigitch in Risk Management and our legal counsel Ben Onofrio regarding student information being provided for tutoring services. They both indicated that the district would be unable to support this type of information sharing system due to the liability on all sides. The best way to establish these connections would be for private parties to make these tutoring connections.
